

- 2 They eat it and feed it to the queen. AMDRO' Fire Ant Bait starts to kill ants immediately.
- 3 In about a week the queen is dead, which destroys the mound.

Outdoor Use

For Individual mounds: Sprinkle 2 to 5 level tablespoons of this product around the mound. Do not disturb the mound. Use a disposable scoop (do not use a kilchen utensil). For best results, apply AMDRO' Fire Ant Bait when ants are active. Repeat application



AMDRO Fire Ant Bait controls imported and native fire ants and other ants, such as harvester ants, bigheaded ants and Argentine ants. AMDRO® Fire Ant Bait is for use narvester ants, nigheadord ants and orgentine ants. Ambus or the Amt Sait is for its ONLY on lawns, landscaped areas, golf courses, commercial grounds, parks and other noncropland areas, as well as on grounds surrounding poultry houses (excluding runs and ranges) or corrals and other animal holding areas. Do not graze or feed treated lawn or sod (lippings to livestock. Avoid direct exposure of animals to AMDRO* Fire Ant Bait granules.

Possicids Storage: Store in cool, dry, secure place and keep container closed. Store container away from pets. When properly stored, this product will retain its effectiveness for up to 3 months after the package has been opened.
