OUTDOOR USE

For large, infested areas: Using a hand-held granular spreader, broadcast Amdro" Fire Ant Killer for Mounds at 2 to 4 ounces per 5,000 square feet (1 to 2 pounds per acre). Do not exceed four broadcast applications per year. Observe a minimum retreatment interval for broadcast applications of 30 days.

For individual mounds: Sprinkle 2 to 5 level tables poons of this product around the mound. Do not disturb the mound. Use a disposable scoop (do not use a kitchen utensil).
